If you're waiting for someone else to start something, consider that you might be that someone else.

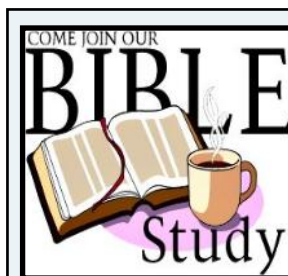
The church has never been a one-person ministry. It takes all of us. Every member brings gifts, ideas, talents, and passions that help shape our life together.

This is also a time when many of the regular Hope activities take a summer pause. But this does not mean that nothing is happening at church, rather it is a time for us to reset before beginning the busy Fall season.

Congratulations to our newly elected council members for 2026-2027. Kari Dahl, Helena Dummler, Evelyn Gertsch, Nick Holl, and Frank Lin will be joining our council starting July 1. Thanks to everyone who attended our Annual Congregation Meeting on June 7th to elect the new members. Those of you who attended are aware that my time on Hope’s Council will come to an end on June 30. Don Hermansen has agreed to serve as your next council president. These roles are tentative and may change until they are ratified by the council at the first meeting of the new council in July.

After our congregation meeting, the biggest news this month was the installation of our new sanctuary roof safety line and access ladder. Most of this construction was completed on June 16th, and the new ladder was blessed following our Worship service on June 21. The crew from Lynn Safety will be returning to Hope in July to install the final component, a vertical safety line for the access ladder. Check out the pictures of the project in this month’s voice.

On June 18th, we had a good turnout for the

Hope game night. The general feedback was that this was something participants would like to repeat again in the coming months. We are planning a second event on Friday August 21. These were blessed and presented to Reyna Sandoval, the Director of Food and Community Services at Samaritan House, during our worship service on June 28th. Reyna also provided an overview of how Samaritan House helps community members in need in San Mateo county, which was a great illustration of the Parable of the Good Samaritan and how it can apply to our current day lives. As a follow up to Reyna’s visit, we will be running a donation campaign in the month of July to raise funds and collect clothes for the back to school drive for the Samaritan House Kids Closet. 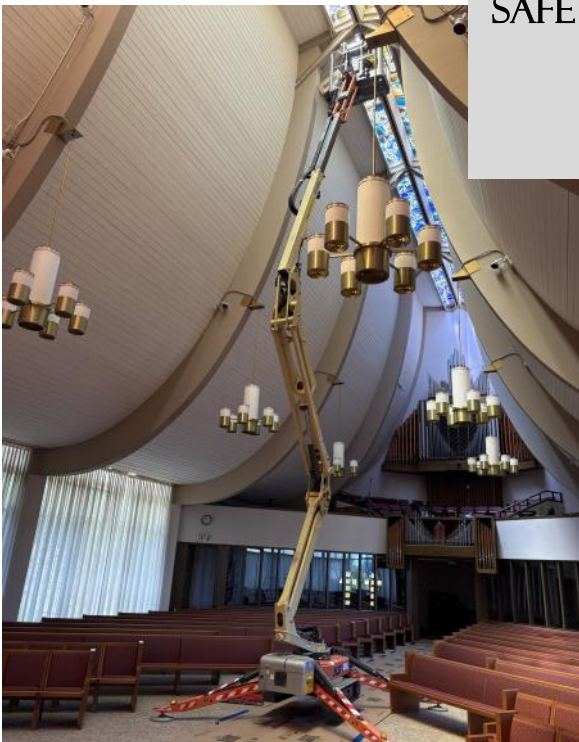

SAFETY LINE & LADDER INSTALLATION JUNE 2026

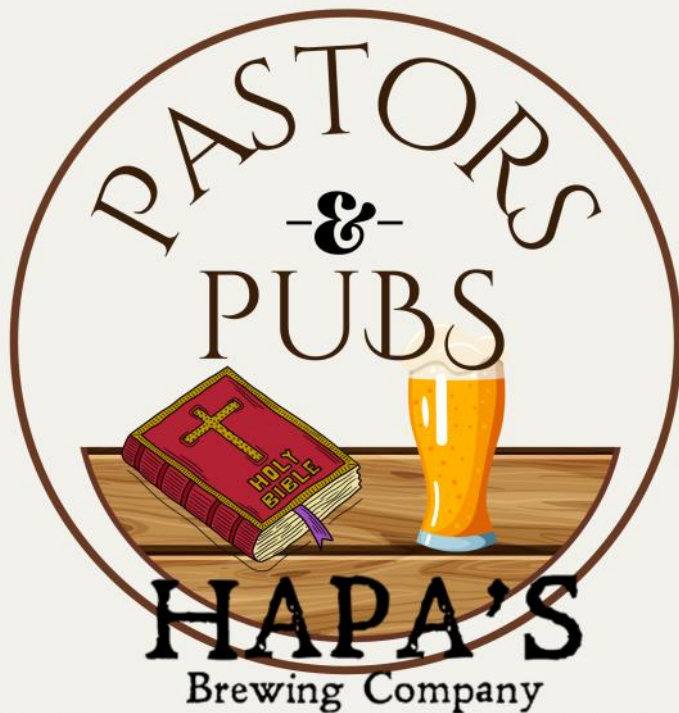

Sierra Pacific Synod Assembly 2026 Business Session Recap

During the meeting, we elected a new Synod Vice President, Sal Espino (Resurrection Lutheran, Granite Bay), and gave thanks for the faithful leadership of outgoing Vice President Simon Wong (Hope Lutheran, El Sobrante). We also elected Beth Williamson (Davis Lutheran) and The Rev. Dr. Gabriele Schroeder (Faith Lutheran, Meadow Vista) to serve on the Synod Council.

Assembly participants approved resolutions on compensation for rostered leaders and organizing for climate action. Details about these resolutions can be found on the synod website: www.spselca.org/blog/synod-assembly-2026-business-session-recap

We heard a compelling call from Pastor Daniel Solberg (St. Paulus Lutheran, San Francisco) to faithfully resist tyranny and authoritarianism. Treasurer Scott Taylor (St. Mark's Lutheran, San Francisco) shared news of a clean audit and preparations for the September budget assembly, while Jim Kowalski (St. Francis Lutheran, San Francisco) highlighted the transformational impact of the Synod's Generosity Team.

As we conclude this year's assembly, we give thanks for all who served, led, and participated. May God continue to guide the Sierra Pacific Synod as we walk the
